# 446/16 Matters arising from previous Meeting

Porthcothan Car Park toilets: The problems continue with either individuals jamming the coin slots and contaminating the coin slots with liquid. The Ladies continues to get blockages and broken flushes. There is a dispute with CC regarding the cleaning bills, but August did produce a healthy income. It was agreed to close the Men's and Ladies from now till half term, but to keep the Disabled open. This will save cleaning expenditure.

## 447/16 **Planning Application**

PA16/05658 Mr Malcolm Fallis. Road from Engollan to Downhill. Demolition of existing workshop and store, removal of caravan and construction of a Replacement workshop, store, office, associated car parking, amenity space and associated works.

After discussion the Councillors agreed to object to this Application on the following grounds:

The proposed replacement dwelling is an overdevelopment of the site, in size and to the proximity to the track.

The lane to the site will be shared, therefore excessive use will hinder the existing inhabited dwelling beyond the proposed development.

The proposed materials to be used do not seem to conform to the St Eval Neighbourhood plan.

It is not in keeping with other developments in the surrounding area.

The inclusion of a toilet in a working environment seems a natural development, but a shower seems excessive, for the type of use intended.
